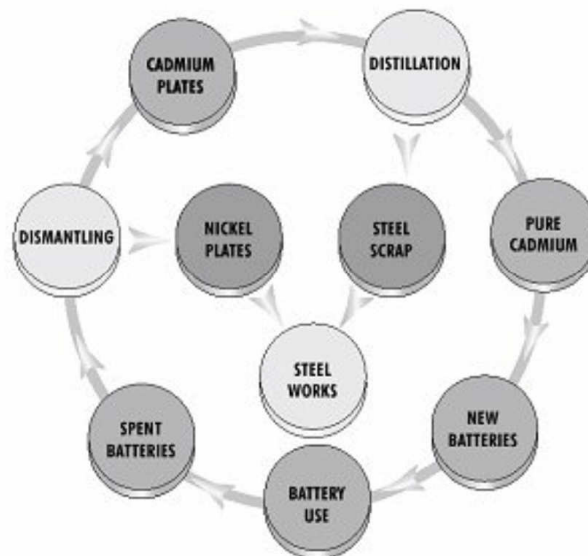

## Industrial Nickel-Cadmium Battery Recycling

When an industrial nickel-cadmium battery reaches the end of its long service life it must be disposed of in accordance with UK and European legislation requirements. It is important to remember that this is a legal requirement for nickel-cadmium and lead acid rechargeable batteries and they cannot be discarded as harmless waste.

Owners and users are legally responsible for the safe disposal of the batteries and it is recommended that they should be returned via the manufacturers approved service organisation for safe recovery and recycling.

The simple and unique natures of the nickel-cadmium battery's components make them readily recyclable, nevertheless, the batteries contain heavy metals with a corrosive liquid and must be treated carefully in accordance with local and national government regulatory controls.



If you intend to handle spent batteries you should familiarise yourself with current regulations governing reportable storage quantities, allowable storage periods and transport requirements to a licensed UK collection point.

IBLUK are the main UK distributor for Alcad & Saft industrial battery products and support the manufacturers commitment to maintaining a cleaner environment.

Alcad and Saft have put in place a system of recycling for the UK market called 'Bat Re Back'. The objective of this scheme is to ensure the safe transportation to a collection point and recycling of un-serviceable nickel-cadmium batteries of whatever brand.
